'Christian Identity and Israel' Subject of Knoll Lecture

Achsah Guibbory, Ann Whitney Olin professor of English at Barnard College, Columbia University, will give the 2009-10 Robert E. Knoll Lecture at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

Her talk, "Christian Identity and Israel: The Case of 17th-century England," will be at 7:30 p.m. in the Van Brunt Visitors Center, 313 N. 13th St. The event is free and open to the public, and will be followed by a dessert reception. The lecture will consider several historical and literary figures, including King James I, Oliver Cromwell and John Milton, but will focus mostly on the Civil War period -- on the eccentric men and women who claimed to be "biblical prophets" warning English Israel of doom, and the "Leveller" Gerrard Winstanley's radical communist proposals, based on his re-reading of the Hebrew Bible.

Barking Water, The Visionmaker Film Festival Play at the Ross

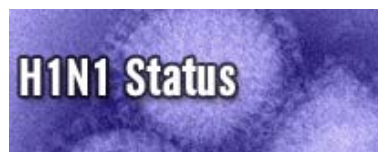
