The scarves entitled, *How Wild is Your Joker?*, *Metalling with Fibers VIII*, and *Murky Meadows* represent the variety of structural and surface textile design techniques that Sanders uses; such as knitting, felting, beading, dyeing, and embroidery.

The scarves were on exhibit May 23 – August 23, 2008 during the Handweaver's Guild of America Convergence 2008 conference in St. Petersburg, Florida. Seventy-seven entries were submitted and 32 were accepted in this exhibit focusing on accessories. Juror for the exhibit was Victoria Z. Rivers, a professor at the University of California-Davis in the Design Department since 1980. Rivers is an artist, a researcher, a writer, and a lecturer of textiles and design, plus the author of *The Shining Cloth: Dress and Adornment that Glitter*.

Sanders received her bachelor's and master's degrees in Apparel and Merchandising from Colorado State University, and her doctorate in Textiles, Clothing, and Design from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. She has had over 42 designs accepted and exhibited in juried competition during her career.
